Communication

Communication is at the heart of everything we do in Ladybird class. This term we will continue to communicate through spoken words, Makaton and PECs. Our focus with Makaton is signing the weather and our names. We practice our PECs at various times through the day. Having our own choices is important and we are getting great at expressing these through PECs. Song and story time is a huge part of our day too, this helps us so much with confidence and communicating with each other.

Physical & Outdoors

We will continue to develop our confidence and gross motor skills in our weekly swimming sessions. Literacy

Each week we have a 'sound of the week', leading daily sessions repeating them to help master new skills and boost confidence in phonics. This term our book focus is Nursery Rhymes and we will be using our PECS to explore characters in our stories.

We will be exploring natural materials and how they can be used in different ways.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

Numbers are involved in all we do in Ladybirds, singing, role play, painting and lots more! We will work on number recognition and representing numbers through explorative play. We will focus on the numbers 0 -10. We will continue to explore length and will be comparing different lengths using long and short as a comparison.

Creative

We are discovering yoga and how to move and stretch our bodies. We will also be continuing exploring instruments to help bring our Nursery Rhymes to life. Our art this term will be focused on our weekly story, we will exploring different textures and techniques to create our piece of art.
