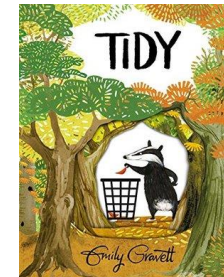
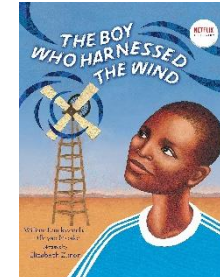
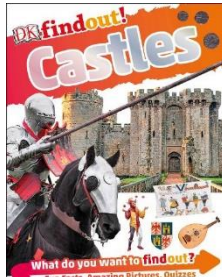
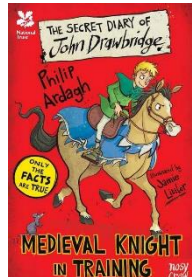
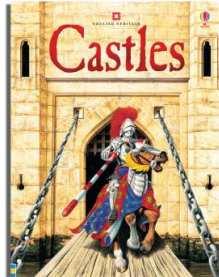
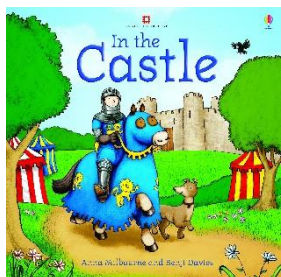


Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

Children will continue to receive small group Read, Write, Inc phonics sessions. Every fortnight they will focus on a new sound to support their developing reading and spelling skills. Children will segment and break down words into sounds so they can independently spell words, while learning “red” (exception) words so that they can write full phonetically plausible sentences.

Science

Could I be an inventor?

Our topic this half term will be scientists and inventors. We will discover what it really means to be a scientist, and what scientists can do by exploring the lives and inventions of real people. We will develop our understanding of how science has changed lives and we will continue to build our ability to work scientifically as we consider and try and design our own inventions!

Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

Why should I take care of the environment?

In PSHE we will be explore how we can take care of our immediate environment such as our home and school, as well as the wider environment. We will consider what would happen if nobody took care of the environment and develop our own understanding of why looking after our surroundings is important.



Castles

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Who lived inside Northumbrian Castles?

This half term we will be covering local history and looking at our county’s magnificent castles. We will be exploring the castles themselves, through lessons and class trips, as well as discovering the histories of the people who lived inside of them.

Therapeutic Input

Alongside input from SaLT and OT we will be developing our fine motor skills through therapeutty and exercises in class to help enable us to fasten buttons, zips and tie laces independently.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

This half term while we continue to practice our calculating skills and place value knowledge, we will be developing our knowledge of statistics and probability.

We will learn how to interpret and draw tables, pictograms, line graphs and bar charts and apply this knowledge to answer questions and solve problems.

Computing

What can I do on a computer?

This half term we will be using and applying the skills we have learned across the year to create a project about staying safe online.

The Arts

How do I create art through collage?

We will be revisiting Picasso through a different lens by exploring collage. We will continue to develop our ability to discuss artwork by comparing a range of collages. Throughout the half term we will utilise our creativity skills creating our own personalised collages.
